

BETHEL ORIENTEERING ONE MILE COURSE

From the back door, walk to the Peace Trail sign: Zack Reising, Troop 183

Counting paces, Follow the inner loop of the Peace Trail – past shelter, along the field south to the treeline, west to the trail junction

Enter the number of paces here _____ (Divide by 10 to have your 100ft pace length)

Then north along the trail back to the sign 1160 feet

Take a bearing of 355° , 110 feet. Using the trail walk to this location: Jackson Von Blon, Troop 101

Bearing 80° for 330 feet. Using the trail walk to this spot: Luke Staebler, Troop 103

Using a map, take a bearing of 220° , 592 feet

Use trail to get most of the way to this area, then cross the yard to fence: Aiden Bid-
dle, Troop 101

A bearing of 235° about 383 feet takes you to the church sign at the corner of 206th
and Cumberland. Go there

Estimate the height of this sign. _____

Use your map again. A bearing of 41° approximately 913 feet is a structure: Sam
Staebler, Troop 103

Using the parking lots and trails, walk there.

Bearing 244° approximately 405 feet. Using trails, walk there: Jacob Bolling, Troop
150

What is the approximate length and width of Jacob's Garden? _____
